## RULES

The time control for all games shall be as follows:

60 minutes for each player in which to make 30 moves.

After 30 moves clocks are put back 15 minutes and the game is played to conclusion within that time limit.

There are no adjudications or adjournments. All games must be completed within each session, either by a conclusive result, an agreed result, or because one player has lost on time.

Wherever there are insufficient players to complete a league, a player or players called 'bye' shall make up the numbers. 'Bye' shall always lose his games, but a win against 'bye' shall always be regarded as a win with the White pieces.

Players must notify the secretary of their results at the end of each session.

Points will be awarded as follows: one for a win, half for a draw, none for a loss. The total points scored in a round will decide the positions in the leagues at the end of each round. In the event of two or more players tying on points their positions will be decided by the following tie break procedure, using as many criteria as necessary to resolve the tie in the following order (in Round 2 games from both rounds will be considered):

Highest number of wins

Highest number of wins with Black pieces.

Highest number of draws with Black pieces.

The result of the game(s) between the tied players.

(Round 2 only) The players' respective positions from Round 1.

Drawing lots.

## THE FORMAT

### Round 1 (Sessions 1-5)

Players are split into two groups, A and B, and each player plays each other in his group as shown on the following pages.

The groups have been seeded according to players' CCCC internal grading score, so that each group has an almost equal total score. Group A has a total score of 285 (268 from the top 5 players). Group B has a total score of 275. The lower seeds in each group have been given the extra game with the white pieces.

At the end of this round, players will be allocated to new groups according to their position in the group. These groups will form the basis of Round 2.

### Round 2 (Sessions 6-7)

Three further groups will be formed as follows:

Group C consists of the 1st and 2nd placed players from Groups A & B.  
Group D consists of the 3rd and 4th placed players from Groups A & B.  
Group E consists of the 5th and 6th placed players from Groups A & B.

Players will again play each other player in their group, except that the games that have already taken place in Round 1 (e.g. A1vA2; B1vB2) will be carried forward and count again in this round. These games will however only count once in the event of the tie break procedures outlined above coming into effect.

The winner of Group C will be considered the winner of the tournament, and other places determined as shown towards the end of this booklet.
